(This doesn't have to be the publishing of digital work/projects, though it can be, if desired.)</li><li>o Once you have your final links, <b>send/share the links with Tammy or Lauren.</b> (This can be done in conjunction with Element 4.)</li></ul>

- ~ Every tutorial in Sophia contains **one written answer** (at the bottom of the page) and **one short quiz** (at the top right corner of the page.)

- ~ If you already know enough to demonstrate mastery without watching videos/reading content, go ahead and do it!
